WHEREAS, An array of honors and awards bears witness to the high regard in which Officer Ronnie Mitnitsky has been held by his peers and colleagues, including the Township of Springfield's Citizenship Award and the Auxiliary Police Officer of the Year Award; and,

WHEREAS, Ronnie Mitnitsky, who joined the Springfield Auxiliary Police in 1968, is the last of the original members in the unit, and he retired as a Corporal; and,

WHEREAS, Named a Life Member of the Auxiliary Police in 2016, Ronnie Mitnitsky still responds to all events in which Emergency Management has a role, further evidence of his uncommon level of public-spiritedness; and,

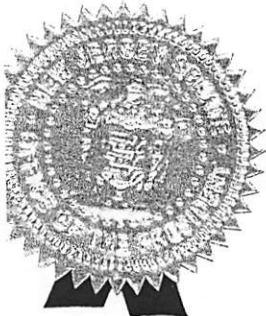


